Based at the Jersey Shore, **the Plein Air Painters of the Jersey Coast (The PAPJC)** is a group of artists who want to explore the beauty around them by painting “en plein air,” a term that is used to describe painting that is done outdoors. This type of painting lets artists capture the unique colors and atmospheric effects that are too often lost when painting from photographs. Whether a study or a full-fledged painting, work that is done en plein air often has a fresh, spontaneous look that is missing from studio work.

Since its founding in 2003, members of the PAPJC meet and paint every Monday throughout the year in all but the worst weather. The group usually stays at the same site for two consecutive weeks. At the end of the second session, there is a show and tell and an optional critique. Our weekly painting schedule is posted on our website (www.thepapjc.com). Artists who are not seeking membership, but who simply wish to paint with a congenial group, are welcome to join us at any Monday session. No instruction is offered, but more experienced members share techniques and encourage the development of newer artists.

The PAPJC often participates in invitational paint-outs, and it has been recognized in national publications for its outstanding work benefiting the community through art. It recently developed a program whose main objective is to contribute to a major healthcare facility in the area. The recurring River Views Exhibit and Gala, an invitation-only event that has raised thousands of dollars for the Jane H. and John Marshall Booker Center at Riverview Medical Center, is an example of this program.

Each year, the PAPJC has an art exhibit showcasing their members’ works from the past year. In 2011, this exhibit will be held in November at the Middletown Art Center in Middletown, NJ, and will feature a Small Works Show, large-scale paintings, and an educational program centered around plein air painting. The PAPJC recently introduced Signature membership for its most experienced painters, and planning is underway for a juried exhibit to showcase the work of our new Signature members. PAPJC painters are among the finest in the region, and many have been nationally recognized. Their works grace the homes and businesses of many art lovers in New Jersey and elsewhere.
