

## **Weekly Outings**

## **Asbury Park**

**Meet at:** The old Carousel building at the south end of Kingsley Ave, Asbury Park, where Cookman Ave., Asbury Ave., and Kingsley all intersect.

**Supplemental Directions:** Coming south on Ocean Ave, pass through Deal and Allenhurst. Turn left when Ocean Ave. T's and go around Deal Lake. The first left is Kingsley. Continue south on Kingsley until you see the old Carousel building.

Via the Garden State Parkway from the NORTH. Garden State Parkway south to exit 102 Asbury Park. Follow Asbury Ave/Route 66 approximately 6 miles to Asbury Park. Follow the signs for Asbury Park once you get off the parkway.

Via the Garden State Parkway from the SOUTH. Garden State Parkway North to exit 100-A Asbury Park. Follow Route 66/Asbury Avenue approximately 6 miles to Asbury Park.

## Parking:

You will have to pay for parking. Meters must be fed – we think – every two hours. Be sure to double-check when you park. – And plan to come early to get a spot near the boardwalk.

## **Description of Painting Locations:**

Asbury Park is a city rich in memories and future promises. For the painter, it offers a wide range of subjects:

- The boardwalk and beach
- Architectural remnants of its destination as a summer playground
- A new up-scale downtown
- Picturesque (and not so picturesque) buildings from before the towns growing recovery
- Views of Ocean Grove homes across Wesley Lake
