Directions: Surfer Beach, Sea Bright

For long time residents, this is where The Peninsula House was. It's between the Surfrider Beach Club (931 Ocean Ave.) and the Sea Bright Beach Club (999 Ocean Ave.).

Coming from Rumson Road, go over the Shrewsbury Bridge and make a left onto Ocean Ave. The Surfer Beach is the first right. You will see a porta john and stairs to the beach.

Parking: Free parking (limited to about 25 spots). Best to get there early (7-9 a.m.) to get a spot.

Description of Painting Locations:

There are views of the ocean, rock jetty (that usually has someone fishing on it), and, of course, the beach clubs. (It used to have dunes with a lovely path through the sea grass, but Superstorm Sandy may have changed that.) It still remains a popular destination for local surfers, swimmers, fishermen, and sunbathers.

You can walk down and paint the beach clubs providing you stay below the high tide mark. Workers are usually out raking the private beaches between 9-10 a.m. The beach clubs open at 10, and when that happens, you may be asked to move below the high tide mark.
