Historic Walnford at Crosswicks Creek Greenway

Address: 62 Walnford Rd., Upper Freehold

Meet at: The bright blue grist mill

Directions:

Take Rt. 9, 79, or 34 South to 537 West to Rt. 539 in Upper Freehold. Turn right onto Rt.539, (Forked River Rd.), then left on Burlington Path Road. Turn right onto Holmes Mill Road and left on Walnford Road which leads directly into the park.
